1 GDPR

The [General Data Protection Regulation \(GDPR\)](#) is an EU regulation that establishes a new legal framework to protect the personal data of EU residents. Organizations that are established in the EU, as well as organizations that process personal data of EU residents, are required to comply with the GDPR. 2 Cookies

What Are Cookies?

As is common practice with almost all professional websites, website uses cookies, which are tiny files that are downloaded to your computer, to improve your experience. This page describes what information they gather, how we use it and why we sometimes need to store these cookies. We will also share how you can prevent these cookies from being stored however this may downgrade or 'break' certain elements of the site's functionality. How We Use Cookies

We use cookies for a variety of reasons detailed below. Unfortunately, in most cases there are no industry standard options for disabling cookies without completely disabling the functionality and features they add to our website. It is recommended that you leave on all cookies if you are not sure whether you need them or not in case they are used to provide a service that you use.

Disabling Cookies

If cookies are automatically enabled in your browser, we will assume that you have accepted them. You can prevent the setting of cookies by adjusting the settings on your browser (see your browser Help for how to do this). Be aware that disabling cookies will affect the functionality of our website and many other websites that you visit. Disabling cookies will usually result in also disabling certain functionality and features of the this site. Therefore it is recommended that you do not disable cookies.

The Cookies We Set

If you login to our website, then we will use cookies for the management of the signup process and general administration. These cookies will usually be deleted when you log out. However in some cases they may remain afterwards to remember your site preferences when logged out. We use cookies when you are logged in so that we can remember this fact. This prevents you from having to log in every single time you visit a new page. These cookies are typically removed or cleared when you log out to ensure that you can only access restricted features and areas when logged in.

Third Party Cookies

Third Party Cookies. In some special cases we also use cookies provided by trusted third parties. The following section details which third party cookies you might encounter through this site.

Our website uses Google Analytics, which is a trusted analytics solution on the web that helps us understand how you use the site and shows us ways to improve your experience. These cookies may track things such as how long you spend on the site and the pages you visit so we can continue to produce engaging content.
